## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-36-303 AND 27-49-219  
10 TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLOR OF EMERGENCY LIGHTS USED ON  
11 POLICE VEHICLES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

13 TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-36-303 AND 27-  
14 49-219 TO PROVIDE FOR THE COLOR OF  
15 EMERGENCY LIGHTS USED ON POLICE

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-36-303, concerning police vehicles, is  
23 amended to read as follows:

24 27-36-303. Police vehicles.

25 All state, county, or city and municipal police agencies shall install,  
26 maintain, and exhibit blue or a combination of blue and white rotating or  
27 flashing emergency lights upon all police motor vehicles which are equipped  
28 with emergency lighting and operated within the State of Arkansas.  
29

30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-49-219(d)(1), concerning emergency vehicles,  
31 is amended to read as follows:

32 (d)(1) "Authorized emergency vehicle" means authorized emergency  
33 vehicles which shall include:

34 (A) Motor vehicles used by state, county, or city and  
35 municipal police agencies, all of which shall be equipped with:

36 (i) Blue; or

1 (ii) ~~Blue, red, or~~ A combination of blue and white  
2 rotating or flashing emergency lights;

4 SECTION 3. Nothing in this act shall prevent the use of amber "traffic  
5 control" lights by state, county, or city and municipal police agencies.
