22	SECTION 2. <u>EMERGENCY CLAUSE</u> . It is hereby found and determined by the		
23	Eighty-third General Assembly that the effective date of this act shall be		
24	July 1, 2001, in that the fiscal year for all state agencies begins on July 1;		
25	that for purposes of accounting and record keeping it is necessary that the		
26	changes made by this act to the collection of fees by the Commissioner of		
27	State Lands be implemented on a date corresponding with the start of the		
28	fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being		
29	immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and		
30	safety shall become effective on July 1, 2001.		
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
