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8 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE 9 NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP -There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education -10 11 Educational Television Division - State for the 1999-01 2001-2003 biennium, 12 the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known 13 as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: 14 five (5) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to 15 exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or 16 its successor, for the appropriate classification. 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SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA HELP - DIGITAL SATELLITE NETWORK - FEDERAL. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division - Digital Satellite Network - Federal for the 1999-01 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: One (1) temporary

or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the appropriate classification. Many of these positions are related to specific projects, and those positions so related are specifically exempt from limitations of hours, either by act or regulation.

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SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SPECIAL LANGUAGE - CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the construction of a joint AETN/UCA complex, the Department of Education, Educational Television Division shall establish and maintain for the 1999-2001 2001-2003 biennium a pool of fifteen (15) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes. These positions are to be used by the Department of Education-Educational Television Division in the event that the number and level of positions available to address the needs emerging from the construction of this new facility and the opportunity it presents to expand programming exceeds the classified positions regularly authorized for the Department of Education - Educational Television Division by the Legislature. (b) The Department of Education - Educational Television Division shall provide justification to the Department of Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this position pool. No classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as

- 1 specific positions are requested and justified by the Department of Education-
- 2 Educational Television Division, recommended by OPM and approved by the
- 3 Arkansas Legislative Council. The Department of Education- Educational
- 4 Television Division may transfer positions and appropriations from this pool
- 5 to any appropriation/pay schedule the agency currently maintains or any
- 6 appropriation/pay schedule the agency receives during the 1999-2001 2001-2003
- 7 bi enni um.
- 8 [c] Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
- 9 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
- 10 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
- 11 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
- 12 determined that Department of Education Educational Television Division
- 13 could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that
- 14 agency. That flexibility is being accomplished by providing growth pools in
- 15 subsection (a) of this section and since the General Assembly has granted the
- 16 agency broad powers under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and
- 17 appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of
- 18 the growth pool by requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the
- 19 utilization of the growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the
- 20 Legislative Council is not a severable part of this section. If the
- 21 requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional
- 22 by a court jurisdiction, this entire section is void.

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The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

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- SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PROMOTIONAL ITEMS. The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall establish upon request for the Department of Education Educational Television Division a special appropriation line item to be used in the acquisition of promotional items. When the Department of Education Educational Television Division wishes to transfer monies from its operating expenses appropriation to the promotional items line, the AETN Commission shall approve the request and forward it to
- 35 the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State for processing. The Legislative Council
- 36 shall also be informed of the transfer.

1 2 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 3 through June 30, 2003. 4 5 SECTION 11. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all 6 7 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall 8 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly 9 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to 10 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the 11 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. 12 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency 13 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall 14 15 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall 16 include the following: 17 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such 18 expenditures on the fund balance. 19 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or 20 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 21 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 22 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not 23 24 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent 25 depletion of the fund balance. 26 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and 27 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought 28 prior review by the Legislative Council. 29 30

SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of

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1	Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
2	with in disbursement of said funds.
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4	SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
5	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
6	in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
7	was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
8	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
9	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
10	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
11	Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
12	
13	SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
14	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
15	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
16	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
17	agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
18	event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
19	of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
20	administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
21	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
22	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
23	force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
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
