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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Arkansas Tech University for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum
25 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions
26 of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201
27 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided,
28 however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set
29 out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
33 successor.

 6 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 7 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FOOD
 8 SERVICE. If Arkansas Tech University cancels the current contract for food
 9 service and chooses to operate the food service with University employees, the
 10 President, upon authorization of the Board of Trustees, is allowed to utilize
 11 the contingent positions contained in Section 1 of this Act, provided he or
 12 she has obtained approval from the Department of Higher Education and the
 13 Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, who has sought prior review by the Arkansas
 14 Legislative Council.

15
 16 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
 17 through June 30, 2003.

18
 19 SECTION 11. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
 20 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
 21 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
 22 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
 23 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
 24 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
 25 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
 26 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head
 27 shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
 28 requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide
 29 sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the
 30 following:

- 31 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 32 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 33 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
- 34 any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 35 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
- 36 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.

1 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
2 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
3 depletion of the fund balance.

4 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
5 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request , after having sought
6 prior review by the Legislative Council.

7
8 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
10 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
11 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary
12 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures
13 and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures Restrictions Act, or
14 their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where
15 applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and
16 Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in
17 disbursement of said funds.

18
19 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
26 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27
28 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
32 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
33 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
34 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper
35 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
36 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the

1 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
2 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
