21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
22

23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the Arkansas  
24 Employment Security Department for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following  
25 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
26 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
27 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
28 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary  
29 is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said  
30 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions  
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular  
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its  
33 successor.

25 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. EXTRA  
27 HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Employment Security Department for  
28 the ~~1999-2001~~ 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or  
29 temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds  
30 appropriated herein for such purposes: four hundred (400) temporary or part-  
31 time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in  
32 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, for the  
33 appropriate classification. Any of these positions utilized in a manner which  
34 are funded by federal sources are specifically exempt from limitation of  
35 hours, either by Act or Regulation. The provisions of this section shall be  
36 in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

2 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
3 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY  
4 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation made by this Act, with the  
5 exception of appropriation made for Regular Salaries and Maintenance and  
6 General Operation, which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June  
7 30, ~~2000~~ 2002, shall be transferred forward and made available for the same  
8 purpose for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2001~~ 2003. The provisions of  
9 this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.  
10

11 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. "REED ACT  
13 FUNDS". Funds made available to the State under Section 903 of the Social  
14 Security Act may be used, under the direction of the Employment Security  
15 Department with respect to federal fiscal year 1999, for the purpose of  
16 construction, and improvement of buildings, rent/lease costs, acquisition of  
17 land and/or for the payment of salaries, ~~and~~ related benefits and maintenance  
18 and operation of central and local office staff. Monies credited with respect  
19 to federal fiscal years 2000, ~~and~~ 2001, 2002 and 2003 shall be used solely for  
20 the administration of the unemployment compensation program or as otherwise  
21 prescribed in Section 903 of the Social Security Act, as amended.

22 The amount obligated pursuant to this Act shall not exceed the amount by  
23 which (a) the aggregate of the amounts transferred to the account of this  
24 State pursuant to Section 903 of the Social Security Act exceeds (b) the  
25 aggregate of the amounts used by this State and charged against the amounts  
26 transferred to the account of this State. The provisions of this section shall  
27 be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.  
28

29 SECTION 20. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ADDITIONAL  
31 POSITIONS. The Director of the Employment Security Department, after  
32 receiving the approval of the Office of Personnel Management, and after  
33 seeking the prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, shall have the  
34 authority to establish such new or additional full time positions as may  
35 become necessary to carry out the objectives of the program and/or to meet  
36 Federal requirements of new and/or expanded programs where such needs are

1 financed by federal funds; provided that not more than two hundred persons may  
2 be employed in addition to those authorized in the salary schedule and that  
3 the rate of pay shall not exceed those set out in the salary schedule for  
4 comparable positions as authorized under the provisions of Section 1 of this  
5 Act. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001  
6 through June 30, 2003.

8 SECTION 21. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
9 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER  
10 OF APPROPRIATION. Subject to such rules and regulations as may be implemented  
11 by the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and after having sought the prior  
12 review by the Arkansas Legislative Council, the Director of the Employment  
13 Security Department is hereby authorized to make transfers from any  
14 appropriation made by this Act to any other appropriation made by this Act  
15 with the exception of the "Reed Act Funds" appropriations set forth in Section  
16 11 of this Act, and of the appropriation made for Regular Salaries or  
17 Maintenance and General Operation. Such transfers may be made whenever it  
18 appears, by projecting the expenditures of any of the appropriations in this  
19 Act, that there will be a deficiency of appropriation in one item and that  
20 there will be a corresponding excess of appropriation in another item or items  
21 which may be transferred. The transfer of appropriation shall be effected  
22 only on approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State. Provided, however,  
23 that no transfer of appropriations may be authorized to increase the total  
24 amount appropriated for Regular Salaries, or Maintenance and General  
25 Operations, except as may be authorized elsewhere by law. The provisions of  
26 this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

27

28 SECTION 22. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
29 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY  
30 FORWARD. Any balance in the General Revenue funds made available by this Act  
31 as matching funds for the Welfare-to-Work Initiative which remains on June 30,  
32 ~~2000~~ 2002, may be carried forward into the next fiscal year, to be used for  
33 the same purpose. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from  
34 July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

36 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

1 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. MATCHING  
2 FUNDS ALLOCATION. The Director of the Employment Security Department, after  
3 review and recommendation from the state Workforce Investment Board and in  
4 coordination with the Arkansas Transitional Employment Board, will allocate  
5 the State General Revenue matching funds and other available welfare-to-work  
6 funds, in accordance with welfare-to-work priorities set by the state and in  
7 accordance with federal requirements. The Director, will implement an in-  
8 depth program evaluation process of welfare-to-work activities and report  
9 results to the Workforce Investment Board and the Transitional Employment  
10 Board. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1,  
11 2001 through June 30, 2003.

12

13 SECTION 24. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
14 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
15 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
16 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary  
17 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures  
18 and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of  
19 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of  
20 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied  
21 with in disbursement of said funds.

22

23 SECTION 25. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
24 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
25 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
26 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
27 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
28 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
29 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint  
30 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

31

32 SECTION 26. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
33 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
34 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
35 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the  
36 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the

1 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date  
2 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
3 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an  
4 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
5 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full  
6 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
