Arkansas Code 16-90-703(2), concerning definitions in the 22 23 Arkansas Crime Victims Reparations Act, is amended to read as follows: (2)(A) "Victim" means a person who suffers personal injury or death as 24 25 a result of criminally injurious conduct committed either within the State of 26 Arkansas or against any Arkansas resident who suffers personal injury as the result of criminally injurious conduct which occurs in states presently not 27 28 having crime victims reparations programs for which the victim is eligible, 29 and further includes any Arkansas resident who is injured or killed by an act of terrorism committed outside of the United States as defined in 18 U.S.C. § 30 31 2331. (B) The term "victim" shall also include a person who: 32 33 (i) Is the child, whether by blood, adoption, or marriage, of a victim as defined in subdivision (2)(A); 34 (i) (ii) Is an immediate family member of a deceased victim, 35 a victim of sexual assault, or a child victim; 36

4	(iii)(iv) Discovered the body of a victim who died as the
