## Subtitle

AN ACT TO EXPAND THE DEFINITION OF  
VICTIM IN THE ARKANSAS CRIME VICTIMS  
REPARATIONS ACT.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
21

22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-90-703(2), concerning definitions in the  
23 Arkansas Crime Victims Reparations Act, is amended to read as follows:

24 (2)(A) "Victim" means a person who suffers personal injury or death as  
25 a result of criminally injurious conduct committed either within the State of  
26 Arkansas or against any Arkansas resident who suffers personal injury as the  
27 result of criminally injurious conduct which occurs in states presently not  
28 having crime victims reparations programs for which the victim is eligible,  
29 and further includes any Arkansas resident who is injured or killed by an act  
30 of terrorism committed outside of the United States as defined in 18 U.S.C. §  
31 2331.

32 (B) The term "victim" shall also include a person who:

33 (i) Is the child, whether by blood, adoption, or marriage,  
34 of a victim as defined in subdivision (2)(A);

35 ~~(i)~~(ii) Is an immediate family member of a deceased victim,  
36 a victim of sexual assault, or a child victim;

1                   ~~(ii)~~(iii) Is not an immediate family member, but who  
2 resided at the time of the crime in the same permanent household as a deceased  
3 victim; or

4                   ~~(iii)~~(iv) Discovered the body of a victim who died as the  
5 result of criminally injurious conduct;
