SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. POSI TI ON 12 Upon approval of the Chief Fiscal Officer, the State Office of TRANSFER. 13 Emergency Services is hereby authorized to transfer positions between appropriations as may be required should a disaster occur which results in a 14 15 Presidential Disaster Proclamation and/or when an employee occupies one 16 position which is to be paid from two or more appropriations during a single 17 fiscal year. SECTION 17. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED 20 21 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all 22 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall 23 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly 24 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to 25 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the 26 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency. 27 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency 28 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the 29 State requesting approval of the expenditures. 28 SECTION 20. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
