35 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PUBLIC
36 DEFENDER. The appropriation provided in Item (06) of Section 1 herein shall

1 be expended only for the purpose of contracting with the Public Defender of
2 Pulaski County to provide defense for the mentally ill. The appropriations
3 made by Items (01), (05) and (09), of Section 1 are to provide state

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26 SECTION 23. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
27 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. JUVENILE
28 TRANSPORTATION. Funds appropriated in Item (12) of Section 1 of this Act
29 shall be used to provide grants/reimbursements to counties and cities for
30 transportation of juvenile offenders to appropriate care or custody
31 facilities or any other licensed juvenile facility approved by the court or
32 as may be provided by law, in those counties which have juvenile detention
33 facilities. Such grants/reimbursements for juvenile transportation costs

8 Association to be used exclusively for the establishment and operation of
9 crime prevention and alcohol and drug abuse programs. The provisions of this
10 section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

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12 SECTION 25. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
13 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. INTENT.
14 It is the intent of the General Assembly that the financing of the Aerospace
15 and Industrial Development Program through a transfer from the State
16 Apportionment Fund is not to be a precedent in financing programs in this
17 state. We recognize that an unusual and possible unique situation exists
18 that requires the General Assembly to deviate from its normal practice of
19 establishing priorities and allowing the programs to receive financing
20 through the Arkansas Revenue Stabilization Law. It is our intent to provide
21 any financial support for the program contained in this act in the future, if
22 any, through the process of it receiving a share of the distribution of the
23 "general revenues available for allocation" in the Arkansas Revenue
24 Stabilization Law. The provisions of this section shall be in effect only
25 from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

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27 SECTION 26. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
29 DISTRIBUTION OF ADMINISTRATION OF JUSTICE FUNDS. In the event that the fund
30 balance in the Administration of Justice Fund is inadequate to fund the
31 monthly allocation to State Agencies, the funds will be distributed as
32 follows:

33 All monthly allocations to State Agencies will be funded in the percentage
34 of the total funds available in the Administration of Justice Fund; that is
35 if less than 100% of the total monthly allocation is available for
36 distribution, all monthly allocations to State Agencies will be funded at an

1 equal percentage consistent with the available funds, provided that any of
2 the allocations listed in Section 27 that have been fully pledged prior to
3 January 1, 2001 to the repayment of a bond issue or bond issues shall not be
4 reduced below the amount listed in Section 27. Any shortage from one month
5 will be adjusted in future months' payments as funds become available. The
6 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through
7 June 30, 2003.

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9 SECTION 27. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS

Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
