## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-51-302(1) TO REQUIRE  
10 VEHICLES TO GIVE A SIGNAL BEFORE CHANGING LANES; AND  
11 FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

14 AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-51-302  
15 (1) TO REQUIRE VEHICLES TO GIVE A SIGNAL  
16 BEFORE CHANGING LANES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-51-302 is amended to read as follows:  
22 27-51-302. Driving on roadways laned for traffic.

23 Whenever any roadway has been divided into two (2) or more clearly  
24 marked lanes for traffic, the following rules in addition to all others  
25 consistent with this subchapter shall apply:

26 (1) A vehicle shall be driven as nearly as practical entirely  
27 within a single lane and shall not be moved from the lane until the driver has  
28 first given the signal required by § 27-51-403(c) and ascertained that  
29 movement can be made with safety;

30 (2) Official signs may be erected directing slow-moving traffic  
31 to use a designated lane or allocating specified lanes to traffic moving in  
32 the same direction, and drivers of vehicles shall obey the directions of every  
33 such sign.
