## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-15-1202(a) TO REPLACE the five dollar fee charged at I SSuance and annual Renewal of military license plates with a ten dollar FEE CHARGED AT I SSUANCE ONLY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 27-15-1202
(a) TO REPLACE THE FIVE DOLLAR FEE CHARGED AT I SSUANCE AND ANNUAL RENEWAL of MI LITARY LICENSE PLATES.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-15-1202(a), concerning license plates for retired military persons, is amended to read as follows:
(a) (1) Upon application, accompanied by proof of retirement fromone (1) of the following services of the armed forces of the United States, upon complying with the state motor vehicle laws relating to registration and I icensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the regular license fee for I icense plates as prescribed by law, plus five dollars (\$5.00) to be deposited to the State Central Services Fund as direct revenues of the Department of Finance and Administration for each special license plate issued or renewed payment of an additional ten dollars (\$10.00) handilng and administrative fee for the issuance of a special license plate, each owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the State of Arkansas and who is retired member of he United States Army, United States Navy, United States Marine Corps, United States Air Force, United States Coast Guard, or the National Guard shall be
issued a special license plate or plates described in § 27-15-1203 for his
private motor vehicle or vehicles, used for his personal conveyance and not
for commercial purposes.
(2) The handiing and administrative fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) shall
be deposited in the state Central Services fund for the benefit of the Revenue
Division and shall be credited to the division as supplemental and in addition
to all other funds as may be deposited for the benefit of the Revenue
Division. The handling and administrative fee shall not be considered or
credited to the division as 'direct revenues'.
(3) Special license plates issued under this subchapter may be renewed
annually at the regular fee. Registration may continue fromyear to year as
long as it is renewed within the time and manner required by law.
