12 AND CERTIFICATE), RESEARCH AND OUTREACH FOCUSED ON THE
13 TREATMENT AND PREVENTION OF ALCOHOL/DRUGS/TOBACCO AND
14 OTHER ADDICTIVE SUBSTANCES USE AND ABUSE; AND FOR
15 OTHER PURPOSES.

18 AN ACT FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF ARKANSAS AT
19 PINE BLUFF - ADDICTION STUDIES PROGRAM
20 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT APPROPRIATION.
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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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26 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - ADDICTION STUDIES PROGRAM. There is hereby
27 established for the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff - Addiction Studies
28 Program for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of regular
29 employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the Uniform
30 Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its
31 successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however, that any
32 position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein in
33 dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform Classification
34 and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions authorized herein are
35 hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular Salaries Procedures and
36 Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its successor.

14 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - ADDICTION STUDIES PROGRAM. There is hereby
 15 appropriated, to the University of Arkansas at Pine Bluff, to be payable from
 16 the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for
 17 personal services and operating expenses of establishing an Addiction Studies
 18 Program with components in education (master's and certificate), research and
 19 outreach focused on the treatment and prevention of alcohol/drugs/tobacco and
 20 other addictive substances use and abuse of the University of Arkansas at Pine
 21 Bluff - Addictive Studies Program for the biennial period ending June 30,
 22 2003, the following:

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2 SECTION 3. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor
3 obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects
4 described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available
5 therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and
6 agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and
7 donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or
8 funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State
9 Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects
10 enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds
11 otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General
12 Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall
13 not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

14 (B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing
15 Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue
16 Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State
17 and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration,
18 as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any
19 funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

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21 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
23 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
28 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
32 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
34 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
35 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
36 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper

1 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
2 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
3 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
4 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
