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19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 17-42-303, concerning educational
22 requirements for real estate salespersons and brokers, is amended by adding
23 an additional subsection to read as follows:

24 (c)(1) The commission shall establish a post-licensure education
25 requirement for individuals in their first year of licensure as a salesperson
26 or broker.

27 (2) The commission shall not require more than thirty (30)
28 classroom hours of post-licensure educational hours.
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30 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 17-42-307, concerning the expiration and
31 renewal of licenses for real estate salespersons and brokers, is amended by
32 adding an additional subsection to read as follows:

33 (d)(1) Beginning January 1, 2002, new salesperson and broker licensees
34 shall complete post-licensure education in accordance with § 17-42-303(c).

35 (2) If the licensee fails to complete the post-licensure
36 education requirements within twelve (12) months after the date the license

1 was issued, the commission shall place the license on inactive status until
2 the commission receives documentation that the licensee has completed the
3 post-licensure education requirements.

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
