## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS PERTAINING TO THE
APPLICATION FORM FOR ABSENTEE BALLOTS; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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BE IT ENACTED by THE GENERAL ASSEmBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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    SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-5-405 is amended to read as follows:
    7-5-405. Application form.
    Applications for absentee ballots may be made on a form furnished by
    the county clerk, and the county clerk shall supply a form substantially
similar to the following form or an electronic facsimile of a substantially
similar form via telephonic transmission on request beginning at least sixty
(60) days before the election:
"IF YOU PROVIDE FALSE INFORMATION ON THIS FORM, YOU MAY BE GUILTY OF
PERJURY AND SUBJECT TO A FINE OF UP TO \$10,000 OR IMPRISONMENT FOR UP TO 10
YEARS.

    The application shall remain in effect for the current calendar year
unless revoked by voter.
NOTE: In accordance with Arkansas Code § 7-5.403, for voters who are
disabled or reside in long-term facilities or who reside outside the county,
this application will automatically remain in effect for the remainder of the
calendar year unless revoked by the voter, and the applicant shall receive,
by mail only, ballots for each election for the remainder of the calendar
year. For voters living within the county in which they are registered to
vote, this application shall only be valid for one (1) election and the
corresponding runoff election, after which the voter shall re-apply.

    (3) Any person may distribute blank applications for absentee ballots.
    SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 7-5-403(b) i s amended to read as follows:
    (b)(1) Any person eligible to vote by absentee ballot may request the
county clerk to mail to an address within the continental United States an
application for an absentee ballot.
    (2)(A) For those persons voting by absentee ballot who reside
outside the county i n which they are registered to vote or in long-term care
or residential facilities licensed by the state, or who are disabled voters
as defined in § 7-5.311, the application shall remain in effect for one (1)
year unless revoked by the voter, and the county clerk shall thereafter
automatically mail, no later than twenty-five (25) days prior to each
election, an absentee ballot for each election.
    (B) Except for persons of long-termcare or residential
facilities licensed by the state or other persons who are disabled voters as
defined in § 7-5-311(d), for those persons voting by absentee ballot who
reside within the county i n which they are regi stered to vote, the
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application shall only be valid for one (1) election cycle. The election cycle shall include any one (1) election and the corresponding runoff election.
