 - (3) Any and all reimbursements and payments to this fund from any source shall be considered a refund to expenditures.

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35 SECTION 30. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 36 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY

- 1 FORWARD. At the close of each fiscal year, the Director of the State Military
- 2 Department shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State the amount,
- 3 <u>if any, of unexpended federal funds for the State Military Department Youth</u>
- 4 Challenge Program remaining in the State Military Department Fund. Such
- 5 amounts, shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose in
- 6 the next succeeding fiscal year. The provisions of this section shall be in
- 7 effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

- 9 SECTION 31. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 10 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TENMPORARY LAW. <u>TEACHER</u>
- 11 SALARY INCREASE PROVISION. During the 2001-03 biennium, the State Military
- 12 <u>Department shall provide the Civilian Student Training Program teachers and</u>
- 13 the Youth Challenge Program teachers salary increases commensurate with the
- 14 *\$3,000 extraordinary salary increase provided to public school district*
- 15 <u>teachers. The extraordinary teacher salary increases authorized by this</u>
- 16 section for the Youth Challenge Program teachers and the Civilian Student
- 17 Training Program teachers shall supplement and not supplant any other salary
- 18 increases authorized for state employees during the 2001-03 biennium.

- 20 SECTION 32. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
- 21 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
- 22 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
- 23 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
- 24 <u>basis</u>. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
- 25 <u>less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the</u>
- 26 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.
- 27 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
- 28 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 29 State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall
- 30 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall
- 31 include the following:
- 32 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 33 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 34 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or
- any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 36 <u>3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs</u>

- 1 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 2 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 3 <u>jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent</u>
- 4 depletion of the fund balance.
- 5 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 6 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 7 prior review by the Legislative Council.

9 SECTION 33. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 12 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary 13 Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of 14 15 this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 16 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

17 with in disbursement of said funds.

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SECTION 34. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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SECTION 35. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 28 29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the 32 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the 33 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper 34 35 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an 36 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
