19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 7-1-103(a)(22), pertaining to miscellaneous  
22 misdemeanor offenses, is amended to read as follows:

23 (22) No election official, poll watcher, or any other person in or out  
24 of this state in any primary, general, or special election in this state  
25 shall divulge to any person the results of any votes cast for any candidate  
26 or on any issue in the election until ~~thirty (30) minutes~~ after the closing  
27 of the polls on the day of the election. The provisions of this subdivision  
28 (22) shall not apply to any township or precinct in this state in which all  
29 of the registered voters therein have voted prior to the closing of the polls  
30 in those instances where there are fifteen (15) or fewer registered voters in  
31 the precinct or township; and
