18	as evidence of the validity or invalidity of the signature. However, if a		
19	signature of a registered voter on such petition is sufficient to verify the		
20	voter's name, then it shall not be adjudged invalid for failure to sign the		
21	name or write the residence and city or town of residence exactly as it		
22	appears on voter registration records, for failure to print the name in the		
23	space provided, for failure to provide the correct date of birth, nor for		
24	failure to provide the correct date of signing the petition, all such		
25	information being an aid to verification rather than a mandatory requirement		
26	to perfect the validity of the signature.		
27	(c) No additional sheets of voter signatures shall be attached to any		
28	such petition unless such sheets contain the full language of the petition.		
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
