AN ACT TO AMEND VARIOUS LAWS REGARDING THE LIBRARY OF
THE SECRETARY OF STATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

TO AMEND VARIOUS LAWS REGARDING THE
LIBRARY OF THE SECRETARY OF STATE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 13-2-302 is amended to read as follows:

13-2-302. Binding of books and documents.

The librarian shall cause to be bound, if not already done, in a cheap and substantial manner, three (3) copies of each of the acts of the General Assembly of this state. ~~following works:-~~

~~(1) The acts of each session of Congress;~~

~~(2) The acts of the General Assembly of this state;~~

~~(3) The acts of every other state of the United States; and~~

~~(4) State papers and documents of the United States.~~

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 13-2-303 is repealed.

~~13-2-303. Books arranged in convenient room.~~

~~The librarian shall cause all books now owned by the state, and as hereafter may be acquired by it, to be thus prepared, arranged, and kept in a convenient room in the State Capitol Building.~~

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 13-2-305 is repealed.

~~13-2-305. Purchase of books directed by General Assembly.~~

~~It shall be the duty of the librarian, under the direction of the
Governor, to purchase all books, maps, and charts as may from time to time be
directed to be purchased by the General Assembly.~~
