Arkansas Code 14-38-101(a), concerning the petitions for 22 23 incorporating cities and towns, is amended to read as follows: 24 14-38-101. Petition for incorporation. 25 (a)(1) When the inhabitants of a part of any county not embraced within 26 the limits of any city or incorporated town shall desire to be organized into a city or incorporated town, they may apply, by a petition in writing, signed 27 by not fewer than seventy-five (75) the greater of either two hundred (200) or 28 29 a majority of the qualified voters residing within the described territory, to the county court of the proper county. 30 31 (2) The petition shall: (A) Describe the territory proposed to be embraced in the 32 33 incorporated town and have annexed to it an accurate map or plat thereof; (B) State the name proposed for the incorporated town; and 34 35 (C) Name the persons authorized to act in behalf of the 36 petitioners in prosecuting the petition.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 14-38-101(b), concerning the petitions for incorporating cities and towns, is amended to read as follows:

(b)(1) The court shall not approve the incorporation of any municipality if any portion of the territory proposed to be embraced in the incorporated town shall lie within five (5) miles from the corporate limits of an existing municipal corporation unless the governing body of the municipal corporation has, by written resolution, affirmatively consented to the

i ncorporati on. (2

- (2)(A) The five-mile limitation shall not apply if the area proposed to be incorporated is separated from the corporate limits of an existing municipality by a natural barrier that makes the area to be incorporated inaccessible to the existing municipality.
- (B) The five-mile limitation shall not apply if the area proposed to be incorporated are lands upon which a real estate development by a single developer, containing not less than five thousand (5,000) four thousand (4,000) acres has been or is being developed under a comprehensive plan for a community containing streets and other public services, parks, and other recreational facilities for common use by the residents thereof, churches, schools, and commercial and residential facilities, and which has been subdivided into sufficient lots for residential use to accommodate a projected population of not fewer than one thousand (1,000) persons, and for which a statement of record has been filed with the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development under the Interstate Land Sales Full Disclosure Act.

- SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 14-38-104(a), concerning the order of incorporation by the county court, is amended to read as follows:
- (a) If the county court shall be satisfied, after hearing the petition, that at least seventy five (75) qualified voters reside therein, or within the limits described by the petition, and that the petition has been signed by them the greater of either two hundred (200) or a majority of the qualified voters residing within the described territory have signed the petition; that the limits have been accurately described and an accurate map or plat thereof made and filed; that the name proposed for the city or incorporated town is proper and sufficient to distinguish it from others of like kind in the state; and, moreover, that it shall be deemed right and proper, in the judgment and

1	discretion of the court, that the petition shall be granted, then the court
2	shall make out and endorse on the petition an order to the effect that the
3	city or incorporated town as named and described in the petition may be
4	organi zed.
