SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE . NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER RESTRICTIONS. The appropriations provided in this act shall not be transferred under the provisions of Arkansas Code 19-4-522 or the provisions of Arkansas Code 6-62-104, but only as provided by this act.

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. <u>TRANSFER PROVISIONS</u>. The state-supported institution of higher education in this act may transfer appropriations between the various line items within each appropriation contained in this appropriation act. Such transfers shall be

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1	made only after the approval of the Department of Higher Education and the
2	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State, and the approval of the Legislative
3	Counci I .
4	The General Assembly has determined that the institution in this act
5	could be operated more efficiently if some flexibility is given to that
6	institution and that flexibility is being accomplished by providing authority
7	to transfer between items of appropriation made by this act. Since the
8	General Assembly has granted the institution broad powers under the transfer

10	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby found and determined by the

14	operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are
15	provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the
16	delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work
17	irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential
18	governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist
19	and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public
20	peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after
21	<u>Jul y 1, 2001.</u>
