SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 26-57-249 is amended to read as follows:
26-57-249. Sale of products upon conviction - Procedure.
(a) (1) Upon conviction of any defendant charged with the violation of this subchapter, the court shall issue an order to sell destroy the tobacco products confiscated by the Director of the Tobacco Control Board, or any state, county, or municipal officer in this state, which were possessed or owned by the defendant and which have not been handled according to the provisions of this subchapter.
(2) The proceeds of the sale of the confiscated tobacco products
together with all fines collected for the violations of this subchapter shall be paid into the state treasury as general revenues.
(b) When tobacco products are sold by order of the court, the Director of the Tobacco Control Board or the officer serving the court shall deliver

the tobacco products to an Arkansas licensed wholesaler who shall sell the
required stamps to the purchaser of the tobacco products.
    (c)(b) Every court of record in this state shall notify the Director of
the Tobacco Control Board of the disposition made of each case in said court
as to whether the defendant was convicted or acquitted.
