14 1999; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE

20 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.
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25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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27 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - OFFICE OF ACCOUNTING. There is hereby
28 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Management
29 Services Division, to be payable from the State Central Services Fund, for the
30 Office of Accounting for consulting services to comply with GASB 34 reporting
31 requirements of the Department of Finance and Administration - Management
32 Services Division which shall be supplemental and in addition to those funds
33 appropriated in Section 3 of Act 1428 of 1999, the following:

4 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the
5 effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall
6 transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of three
7 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$350,000) from the General Revenue Allotment
8 Reserve Fund to the State Central Services Fund Account to provide funds for
9 the appropriation provided herein.

11 *Section 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE*
12 *NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COORDINATION*
13 *WITH LEGISLATIVE AUDIT. The Department of Finance and Administration will*
14 *coordinate with the Division of Legislative Audit to insure that no*
15 *duplication of efforts occurs in complying with GASB 34 reporting*
16 *requirements.*

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18 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by
19 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made
20 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions
21 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures
22 Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and
23 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this
24 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of
25 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied
26 with in disbursement of said funds.

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28 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
29 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
30 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
31 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
32 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
34 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint
35 Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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1 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
2 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
3 the Department of Finance and Administration - Management Services Division
4 are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of
5 Finance and Administration - Management Services Division to continue to
6 provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of this act will
7 provide the necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration
8 - Management Services Division to continue such services; and that a delay in
9 the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper
10 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an
11 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
12 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full
13 force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

14 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
15 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
16 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
17 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the
18 veto.
