HOUSE BILL 1780

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 12-8-104(a)(1),
CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF THE DIRECTOR OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE; AND FOR OTHER
PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT CONCERNING THE APPOINTMENT OF THE
DIRECTOR OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS
STATE POLICE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-8-104(a)(1), concerning the appointment of
the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police, is amended to read as
follows:

(a)(1)(A) The Governor, after conferring with the members of the
Arkansas State Police Commission, shall appoint a Director of the Department
of Arkansas State Police who shall be the executive and administrative head of
the department and shall receive a salary as fixed by law.
The director shall serve at the pleasure of the
Governor.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY. It is found and determined by the General
Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the Arkansas State Police is presently
without a director; that without an emergency clause this act would not be
effective until ninety (90) days after the adjournment sine die of the General
Assembly; that a new director should be appointed before this act would take

1 effect without an emergency clause; and that the members of the Arkansas State
2 Police Commission should be consulted prior to that appointment. Therefore,
3 an emergency is declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for
4 the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall become effective
5 on the date of its approval by the Governor. If the bill is neither approved
6 nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the
7 period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is
8 vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective
9 on the date the last house overrides the veto.
