AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED 16-11-112 TO
AUTHORIZE THE SUPREME COURT TO PROVIDE FOR THE
PUBLICATION OF MODEL CIVIL JURY INSTRUCTIONS; AND FOR
OTHER PURPOSES.

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE ANNOTATED

TO PROVIDE FOR THE PUBLICATION OF MODEL
CIVIL JURY INSTRUCTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-11-112 is amended to read as follows:

16-11-112. Authorization to contract for publication of Arkansas Model
~~Criminal~~ Jury Instructions.

(a) The Arkansas Supreme Court is authorized to provide for the
publication by a private publishing firm firms of the Arkansas Model Criminal
Jury Instructions and the Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions ~~approved by~~
~~order of the Supreme Court~~ for use in the trial courts of this state ~~in~~
~~criminal cases~~.

(b) The Supreme Court shall solicit proposals from reputable
publishing firms and may enter into a ~~contract~~ contracts with the publishing
~~firm~~ firms which ~~is~~ are deemed by the court to offer the best ~~proposal~~
proposals for the separate publication of the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury
Instructions and the Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions, with provision
being made for the publication from time to time of pocket part supplements

1 containing revisions or additions to the instructions ~~as the court may~~
2 ~~approve~~ if the ~~price~~ prices at which the ~~publisher~~ publishers ~~proposes~~
3 propose to sell the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury Instructions and the
4 Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions ~~is~~ are deemed to be reasonable and
5 adequate by the Supreme Court and upon the ~~publisher's~~ publisher agreeing to
6 pay to the Supreme Court, ~~for the use and benefit of the Supreme Court Library~~
7 ~~Fund, a royalty of fifteen percent (15%) of the selling price of each volume~~
8 ~~of the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury Instructions sold~~ a reasonable market-
9 rate royalty for the use and benefit of the Supreme Court Library Fund.

10 (c) The Supreme Court may delegate to the Clerk of the Supreme Court,
11 or to such other employee or official of the court as the court may
12 designate, the responsibility for soliciting and tabulating bid proposals and
13 performing such other duties as may be directed by the court.

14 (d) The awarding of ~~the contract~~ contracts to a private ~~publisher~~
15 publishers for the publication of the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury
16 Instructions and the Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions shall be by a
17 majority vote of the justices of the Arkansas Supreme Court sitting in
18 session for that purpose.
