Authorization to contract for publication of Arkansas Model 25 Criminal Jury Instructions. 26 (a) The Arkansas Supreme Court is authorized to provide for the publication by a private publishing firm firms of the Arkansas Model Criminal 27 Jury Instructions and the Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions approved by 28 29 order of the Supreme Court for use in the trial courts of this state in 30 cri mi nal cases. 31 (b) The Supreme Court shall solicit proposals from reputable 32 publishing firms and may enter into a contract contracts with the publishing 33 firm firms which is are deemed by the court to offer the best proposal proposals for the separate publication of the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury 34 35 Instructions and the Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions, with provision 36 being made for the publication from time to time of pocket part supplements

1	containing revisions or additions to the instructions as the court may
2	approve if the price prices at which the publisher publishers proposes
3	propose to sell the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury Instructions and the
4	Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions is are deemed to be reasonable and
5	adequate by the Supreme Court and upon the <u>publisher's publisher</u> agreeing to
6	pay to the Supreme Court, for the use and benefit of the Supreme Court Library
7	Fund, a royalty of fifteen percent (15%) of the selling price of each volume
8	of the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury Instructions sold <u>a reasonable market-</u>
9	rate royalty for the use and benefit of the Supreme Court Library Fund.

- (c) The Supreme Court may delegate to the Clerk of the Supreme Court, or to such other employee or official of the court as the court may designate, the responsibility for soliciting and tabulating bid proposals and performing such other duties as may be directed by the court.
- (d) The awarding of the contract contracts to a private publisher publishers for the publication of the Arkansas Model Criminal Jury Instructions and the Arkansas Model Civil Jury Instructions shall be by a majority vote of the justices of the Arkansas Supreme Court sitting in session for that purpose.
