13 AN ACT TO REVISE THE APPLICATION OF THE  
14 ARKANSAS CONSUMER TELEPHONE PRIVACY ACT.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
19

20 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 4-99-406, which is a list of exemptions from  
21 the application of the Arkansas Consumer Telephone Privacy Act, is amended by  
22 adding an additional subsection to read as follows:

23 (9) Telephone calls made on behalf of a perpetual care cemetery as  
24 defined by the Cemetery Act for Perpetually Maintained Cemeteries if the  
25 purpose of the telephone call relates to services provided by the cemetery.

27 SECTION 2. [THE ARKANSAS CODE REVISION COMMISSION IS NOT REQUIRED TO  
28 CODIFY THIS SECTION.] In codifying this act, the Arkansas Code Revision  
29 Commission may make any necessary changes to conform Arkansas Code 4-99-406 to  
30 Code style and format.
