19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 9-11-220, concerning the issuance of marriage
22 licenses, is amended by adding an additional subsection to read as follows:

23 (e)(1) If a license has been returned and recorded by the clerk that
24 contains clerical or scrivener's errors, the licensee may submit proof of the
25 error to the circuit court in an ex parte proceeding.

26 (2) The court, upon a finding of error, shall order the county
27 clerk to correct the errors on the license.

28 (3) The licensee shall not be charged a fee for filing a request
29 to correct clerical or scrivener's errors.
