SECTION 5. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Forest Echoes

Technical Institute for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: sixty seven (67) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this

act for the appropriate classification.

10 (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring of the Technical 11 Institutes, Forest Echoes Technical Institute shall establish and maintain for 12 the 1999-2001 2001-2003 biennium a pool of four (4) unclassified positions and 13 three (3) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated for Forest 14 Echoes Technical Institute. These positions are to be used by Forest Echoes 15 Technical Institute in the event that the number and level of positions 16 available to address the needs emerging from business and industry driven 17 program expansions exceeds the number of positions regularly authorized for 18 Forest Echoes Technical Institute.

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20 (b) Forest Echoes Technical Institute shall provide justification to the 21 Department of Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management 22 (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this position pool. 23 classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific 24 positions are requested and justified by Forest Echoes Technical Institute, 25 recommended by OPM and approved by the Legislative Council. Forest Echoes 26 Technical Institute may transfer positions from this pool to any pay schedule 27 the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule the agency receives during 28 the 1999-2001 2001-2003 bi enni um.

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30 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
31 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
32 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
33 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
34 determined that Forest Echoes Technical Institute could be operated more
35 efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is
36 being accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this section

- 1 and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers under the
- 2 growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the General
- 3 Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by requiring
- 4 prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the growth
- 5 pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council is
- 6 not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of approval by the
- 7 Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court jurisdiction, this

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- 22 SECTION 8. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
- 23 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
- 24 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall
- 25 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
- 26 basis. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
- 27 less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the
- 28 disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.

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SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied

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SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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30 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
31 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
32 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
33 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the
34 agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the
35 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date
36 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper

2	emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
