25 Employees in the above classifications who are assigned to maximum security 26 lockup areas, i.e. administrative, segregation, punitive isolation and death 27 row at the maximum security unit, Varner Unit, Cummins Unit, and East 28 Arkansas Regional Unit, are authorized to receive the hazardous duty pay 29 allowance and an additional amount of maximum security incentive pay to five 30 and one-half percent of the annual salary authorized by law. This pay will 31 only be paid while the employee continues to work in the maximum security 32 lockup areas and pay will be discontinued should the employee terminate work 33 in this area.

The amounts received under the provisions of this section shall not be considered as exceeding the maximum authorized annual salary allowance for
