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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 12-12-1009, concerning dissemination of
23 criminal history information, is amended to read as follows:

24 12-12-1009. Dissemination of ~~conviction~~ criminal history information
25 for noncriminal justice purposes.

26 (a) ~~Conviction~~ Criminal history information shall only be made
27 available for the following noncriminal justice purposes:

28 (1) To any local, state, or federal governmental agency that
29 requests the information for the enforcement of a local, state, or federal
30 law; and

31 (2) *To any nongovernmental entity authorized either by the record*
32 *subject in writing or by state or federal law to receive such information; and*
33 *effective January 2, 2002, to other entities according to standards and rules*
34 *establish by the Supervisory Board of the Arkansas Crime Information Center.*
