23	SECTION 1. REGULAR SALA	ARIES. There is hereby esta	ablished for the

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Northwest Technical Institute for the 2001-2003 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: one hundred seven (107) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.

CONTINGENCY. (a) To address needs emerging from the restructuring of the Technical Institutes, Northwest Technical Institute shall establish and maintain for the 1999-2001 2001-2003 biennium a pool of four (4) unclassified positions and three (3) classified positions, payable from funds appropriated for Northwest Technical Institute. These positions are to be used by Northwest Technical Institute in the event that the number and level of positions available to address the needs emerging from business and industry driven program expansions exceeds the number of positions regularly authorized for Northwest Technical Institute.

(b) Northwest Technical Institute shall provide justification to the Department of Finance and Administration's Office of Personnel Management (OPM) for the need to allocate titles from this position pool. No classifications will be assigned to the pool until such time as specific

- 1 positions are requested and justified by Northwest Technical Institute,
- 2 recommended by OPM and approved by the Legislative Council. Northwest
- 3 Technical Institute may transfer positions from this pool to any pay schedule
- 4 the agency currently maintains or any pay schedule the agency receives during
- 5 the 1999-2001 2001-2003 bi enni um.

- 7 (c) Determining the number of personnel to be employed by a state agency is
- 8 the prerogative of the General Assembly and is usually accomplished by
- 9 delineating the maximum number of personnel by identifying job titles and the
- 10 maximum grade or salary attached to those titles. The General Assembly has
- 11 determined that Northwest Technical Institute could be operated more
- 12 efficiently if some flexibility is given to that agency. That flexibility is
- 13 being accomplished by providing growth pools in subsection (a) of this
- 14 section and since the General Assembly has granted the agency broad powers
- 15 under the growth pool concept, it is both necessary and appropriate that the
- 16 General Assembly maintain oversight of the utilization of the growth pool by
- 17 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council in the utilization of the
- 18 growth pool. Therefore, the requirement of approval by the Legislative
- 19 Council is not a severable part of this section. If the requirement of
- 20 approval by the Legislative Council is ruled unconstitutional by a court
- 21 jurisdiction, this entire section is void.
- The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001 through June 30, 2003.

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- SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
- 26 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PART-TIME
- 27 FACULTY. The Technical Institutes are not required to remit a state
- 28 contribution to the state employee insurance trust fund on Workforce
- 29 Education Part-time Faculty Positions unless the position will be utilized
- for more than 1,000 hours a year.
- 31 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2001
- 32 through June 30, 2003.

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- 34 SECTION 8. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED
- 35 SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND BALANCES. (A) For all
- 36 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall

- 1 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly
- 2 <u>basis</u>. If any proposed expenditures would cause a fund balance to decline to
- 3 <u>less than fifty percent (50%) of the balance available on July 1, 2001, the</u>
- 4 <u>disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the agency.</u>
- 5 Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency
- 6 head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the
- 7 <u>State requesting approval of the expenditures.</u> Such documentation shall
- 8 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall
- 9 <u>include the following:</u>
- 10 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
- 11 <u>expenditures on the fund balance.</u>
- 12 <u>2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut</u>
- or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 14 <u>3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs</u>
- or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 16 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
- 17 <u>jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent</u>
- 18 depletion of the fund balance.
- 19 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
- 20 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
- 21 prior review by the Legislative Council.

- 23 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
- 24 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 25 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- 26 restrictions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and
- 27 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 28 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 29 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- 30 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
- 31 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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- 33 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 34 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 36 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations

1	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
2	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
3	testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
4	Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.
5	
6	SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
7	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
8	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
9	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of
10	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
11	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
12	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the
13	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
14	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
15	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
16	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2001.
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
