19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 16-93-103(c) is amended to read as follows:

22 (c) All such parole and probation officers are further authorized to  
23 carry non-state-issued firearms during all hours in which they are not  
24 actively pursuing the obligations and duties of the office to which they are  
25 appointed or employed, ~~pursuant to the restrictions in § 5-73-306~~ as any  
26 other law enforcement officer.
