BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEmbly OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-19-501 is amended to read as follows:
27-19-501. Report required.
The driver of a vehicle of a type subject to registration under the motor vehicle laws of this state which is in any manner involved in an accident within this state, which accident has resulted in damato the property of any one (1) person in excess of five hundred dollars (\$500), or in bodily injury to, or in the death of, any person, shall, within thirty (30) days after such accident, report the accident on a an electronic or paper form approved by the Director of the Department of Finance and Administration to the office subject to the exemptions provided in §§ 27-19-509 and 27-19-604.

SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-19-504 is amended to read as follows:
27-19-504. Proof of insurance.
The existence of insurance must be proved by means of an insurance report, which shall be on an electronic or paper form approved by the office.

SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 27-19-505 is amended to read as follows:

27-19-505. Insurance report.
The insurance report, unless filed electronically, must be signed in ink and forwarded to the office by the liability insurance carrier or an authorized agent of the insurance carrier within fifty (50) days of the date of the accident.
