1 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL. LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY 2 3 OPERATIONS - RECORD RETENTION. It is determined by the General Assembly of 4 the State of Arkansas that immediate needs of TEA recipients must be met to 5 enable that recipient to obtain and maintain work.
