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SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. ALLOCATION RESTRICTION. Of the amounts allocated in Section 4 hereof, it is the intent

- of the General Assembly that such amounts are to be the maximum expended in the applicable fiscal year from the funds as appropriated in Section 3 hereof
- 2 the approcable fiscal year from the runus as appropriated in section 5 hereor
- 3 for the benefit of the appropriate program so enumerated. Provided, however,
- 4 that in the event that unforeseen circumstances occur in either fiscal year
- 5 that would necessitate a transfer of the maximum allocation provided in
- 6 Section 4, hereof from one or more programs to another program or programs as
- 7 enumerated in said Section 4, the Department shall make its request known, and

(A) For all 27 appropriations as provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall 28 29 monitor the level of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly 30 basis.
