## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT CONCERNING LIABILITY FOR THE COST OF CLEANING  
10 UP SITES WHERE A PERSON UNLAWFULLY MANUFACTURED A  
11 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE OR POSSESSED DRUG PARAPHERNALIA  
12 OR CHEMICALS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MANUFACTURING A  
13 CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

15 CONCERNING LIABILITY FOR CLEANING UP  
16 SITES WHERE A PERSON UNLAWFULLY  
17 MANUFACTURED A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE OR  
18 POSSESSED DRUG PARAPHERNALIA OR  
19 CHEMICALS FOR THE PURPOSE OF  
20 MANUFACTURING A CONTROLLED SUBSTANCE.

24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
25

26 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-64-401, concerning criminal penalties under  
27 the Uniform Controlled Substances Act, is amended to add the following  
28 additional subsection:

29 (h)(1) A person who violates this section shall be liable for the cost  
30 of the cleanup of the site or sites where the person:

31 (A) Manufactured a controlled substance; or

32 (B) Possessed drug paraphernalia or chemicals for the  
33 purpose of manufacturing a controlled substance.

34 (2) The person shall be liable to the state or local agency that  
35 was responsible for the site cleanup.
