Arkansas Code 3-5-1204(b), concerning the scope of and restrictions on licenses for microbreweries, is amended to read as follows: 24 25 The director may additionally issue a microbrewery-restaurant 26 distribution permit to a microbrewery-restaurant licensee. 27 (1) This permit will allow the microbrewery-restaurant licensee 28 to: 29 (A) Sell beer or malt beverage of its own manufacture to a wholesale dealer licensed by this state for the purpose of resale to other 30 31 retail license holders as set forth by § 3-4-605 and § 3-5-101, dealing with 32 wholesale distribution of beer and malt beverage. Any microbrewery-restaurant 33 licensee who also holds a microbrewery restaurant distribution permit will be prohibited from selling for off-premises consumption, as allowed in 34 subdivision (a)(3) of this section, except for those sales to a licensed 35 36 wholesaler as provided for in this subdivision; and

(B) Maintain a separate brewing facility as needed to meet demand, except that all facilities utilized by the microbrewery-restaurant licensee shall not in the aggregate produce over five thousand (5,000) barrels of beer and malt beverage per year, and all products produced by any separate facility must be sold to a licensed wholesaler. At no time does this allow any product produced by any separate facility to be transported to the restaurant location for retail sale for consumption on or off the licensed premi ses.
