1 (E) Envelopes to seal the ballots and certificates; 2 (F) Separate sheets containing blank forms of certificates 3 prepared to enable the election officials to properly certify the result of the election, upon which certificates shall be endorsed a blank form of oath 4 5 to be taken by the election officials before entering upon the discharge of 6 their duties: 7 (G) Voter registration application forms for voters using fail-safe voting and other recordkeeping supplies necessary to document fail-8 9 safe voting procedures; and 10 (H) In those counties in which an optical scanner is used 11 to count paper ballots, the marking instrument recommended by the 12 manufacturer of the optical scanner for proper marking on the ballots shall 13 be provided. 14 (b) If the county board designates the county sheriff and he is a 15 candidate for reelection in a contested race, it shall be the duty of the 16 county board to appoint some suitable person or persons in each precinct to perform the duties of the sheriff.
