challenges of voters, if any, to the county board of election commissioners; (3) Ballots: (A) The election officials shall securely envelope the voted ballots separately from the unused ballots and place the ballots in a container with a numbered seal and then deliver the ballots with the tally sheets and other election materials to the county board; and (B) All cancelled ballots shall be preserved separately from the other ballots and returned to the county board; (4) Stub boxes: Sealed stub boxes shall be delivered to the county treasurer for storage. (b) All of the election materials and returns shall be delivered to the county board by the election officials within twenty-four (24) hours immediately after the polls close.
