Disbursement of funds authorized by 4 5 this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made 6 available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions 7 of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and 8 9 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of 10 11 Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 12 with in disbursement of said funds. 13 SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 23 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 24 25 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2001 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the 27 event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date 28 of this Act beyond July 1, 2001 could work irreparable harm upon the proper 29 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an 30 31 emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full 32 33 force and effect from and after July 1, 2001. /s/ Joint Budget Committee 34 35 36
