Arkansas Code 15-11-503 is amended to add an additional 28 subsection to read as follows: 29 "High unemployment" means an unemployment rate equal to or in excess of 30 one hundred fifty percent (150%) of the state's average unemployment rate for 31 the preceding calendar year as specified by statewide annual labor force 32 statistics compiled by the Arkansas Employment Security Department, when the 33 state's annual average unemployment rate is six percent (6%) or below. When the state's annual average unemployment rate is above six percent (6%), "high 34 35 unemployment" means equal to or in excess of three percent (3%) above the state's average unemployment rate for the preceding calendar year as 36

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4	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 15-11-506(b)(3)(D) is amended to read as
5	follows:
6	(D) The approved company shall not receive a credit
7	against the Arkansas sales tax imposed by § 26-52-301 et seq. with respect to
8	any calendar year if÷
9	(i) In any calendar year following the fourth year
10	of the agreement, the tourism attraction project fails to attract at least
11	twenty-five percent (25%) of its visitors from among persons who are not
12	residents of the state; or
13	(ii) In <u>in</u> any calendar year following the first
14	year of the agreement, the tourism attraction project is not operating and
15	open to the public on a regular and persistent basis.
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17	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code 15-11-509(c) is amended to read as follows:
18	(c) The Revenue Division of the Department of Finance and
19	Administration shall authorize an income tax credit allowed under this
20	section shall increase by a factor of four (4) equal to four hundred (400)
21	times the average hourly wage paid, with a maximum credit of six thousand
22	dollars (\$6,000) if the business is located in a <u>high unemployment</u> county
23	that had an unemployment rate equal to or in excess of one hundred fifty
24	percent (150%) of the state's average unemployment rate for the preceding
25	calendar year as specified by statewide annual labor force statistics
26	compiled by the Arkansas Employment Security Department.
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
