2	SECTION 2. <u>Definitions.</u>
3	For purposes of this act:
4	(1)(A) "Wolf-dog hybrid" means any animal which is publicly
5	acknowledged by its owner as being the offspring of a wolf and domestic dog.
6	(B) No animal may be judged to be a wolf or wolf-dog hybrid based
7	strictly on its appearance.
8	
9	SECTION 3. RECORDS.
10	(a) Owners of wolves and wolf-dog hybrids shall maintain all health
11	records of each wolf and wold-dog hybrid, including health certificates,
12	records of immunization and any other documentary evidence pertaining to the
13	health and welfare of the animal.
14	(b) The owner shall maintain records of acquisitions and disposals of
15	hybrids, including the name and address of the person with whom a transaction
16	is conducted, with entries being made on the day of the transaction.
17	(c) Records shall be available for inspection by law enforcement
18	personnel at reasonable hours.
19	
20	SECTION 4. <u>Confinement, Care and Inspections.</u>
21	(a) Wolves and wolf-dog hybrids shall be provided adequate confinement
22	and adequate feeding.
23	(b) Adequate confinement shall include at least:
24	(1) A brick, concrete, or chain link enclosure surrounded by two
25	layers of fencing as follows:
26	(A) For a single animal:
27	(i) Either an inner chain link fence a minimum of
28	fifteen (15) feet long by eight (8) feet wide by ten (10) feet high or an
29	electric fence that prevents climbing over, and either extending two (2) feet
30	underground or employing some other means that prevents digging under;
31	(ii) An outer fence eight (8) feet high with at least
32	four (4) feet between the two (2) fences unless the inner fence is an electric
33	fence, posted with warning signs, and the gate locked at all times;
34	(B) For a pair, double the cage length for a single animal.
35	(C) For more than two (2) animals, add ten (10) feet to the
36	single animal length and width for each additional animal.

2	(3) No more than four (4) total of wolves or wolf-dog hybrids or
3	both per acre.
4	(c) Adequate confinement shall not include tethering of a wolf or wolf-
5	dog hybrid not under the direct supervision and control of the owner or
6	custodi an.
7	(d)(1) Adequate feeding shall include daily feedings and provisions of
8	<u>water.</u>
9	(2) The feed used shall consist of a minimum meat-based protein
10	content of twenty-five percent (25%) and crude fat of fifteen percent (15%),
11	with exceptions for geriatric and overweight animals or under the advice of a
12	<u>licensed veterinarian.</u>
13	(e) Owners and custodians of wolves and wolf-dog hybrids shall allow
14	inspections by law enforcement personnel at reasonable hours to insure
15	adequate confinement and adequate feeding.
16	(f) This section applies only to owners of four (4) or more adult
17	hybrids or wolves, animals one (1) year of age or older.
18	
19	SECTION 5. Entry into the state.
20	(a) Wolves and wolf-dog hybrids may enter into this state only if each
21	animal is accompanied by a certificate of veterinary inspection indicating
22	that the animal is free from disease or exposure to infectious or contagious
23	di sease.
24	(b) No animals from rabies quarantined areas shall be admitted into
25	this state.
26	
27	SECTION 6. (a) Wolves and wolf-dog hybrids are required to be
28	vaccinated by a licensed veterinarian against rabies with a vaccine approved
29	for dog use, and a rabies certificate may be issued.
30	(b) Veterinarians must inform the owner of the wolf or wolf-dog hybrid,
31	preferably in writing, that the vaccination is considered "off label" and that
32	protection against rabies is not guaranteed.
33	(c) If a wolf or wolf-dog hybrid bites a person, the following criteria
34	will be used by an official of the Department of Health in dealing with the
35	<u>ani mal :</u>
36	(1) The decision shall consider, at least:

(2) A secluded den four (4) feet square for each animal.

1	(A) The epidemiology and risk of rabies in the
2	species of animal in question;
3	(B) Possible prior exposure to a rabies vector;
4	(C) Behavior of the animal at the time of the bite;
5	(D) Prior rabies vaccinations; and
6	(E) Other circumstances that may exist.
7	(2) In some situations, the department will consider the
8	initiative and willingness of the individual so exposed to submit to
9	postexposure anti-rabies immunization after being adequately informed of all
10	potential risks;
11	(3) Any biting animal determined to be at significant risk for
12	the transmission of rabies shall upon written order by the Director of the
13	Department of Health, or a specifically designated representative, be humanely
14	killed and the brain tissue submitted for testing; and
15	(4) The department has the authority to order the quarantine of
16	an animal, determined to be a very low risk for the transmission of rabies,
17	for a thirty (30) day observation period as an alternate method to euthanasia
18	and testing.
19	(d) Owners must be notified and given three (3) business days to
20	provide proof to the Department of Health in their animal's defense before the
21	ani mal can be euthani zed.
22	(e) If, in the future, the United States Department of Agriculture
23	approves the use of rabies vaccines in wolves or wolf-dog hybrids or both,
24	then wolves and wolf-dog hybrids will fall under the same regulations as dogs
25	regarding biting humans and rabies control.
26	
27	SECTION 7. (a) If a wolf or wolf-dog hybrid bites a person or injures
28	or destroys another animal while out of its confined area, the person
29	responsible for the adequate confinement of the animal shall, upon conviction,
30	be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
31	(b) If a wolf or wolf-dog hybrid is not adequately confined or fed, the
32	person responsible for adequate confinement or adequate feeding of the animal
33	or both shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
34	(c) A person abandons or releases a wolf or hybrid into the wild shall,
35	upon conviction, be quilty of a Class A misdemeanor.
