Arkansas Code 26-52-402(b), concerning the definition of 22 manufacturing, is amended to read as follows: 23 (b) For the purposes of this section, the terms "manufacturing" or "processing," as used in this section, refer to and include those operations 24 25 commonly understood within their ordinary meaning and shall also include 26 mining, quarrying, refining, extracting oil and gas, cotton ginning, the 27 drying of rice, soybeans, and other grains and the manufacturing of feed, the 28 processing of poultry or eggs and livestock and the hatching of poultry, and 29 printing of all kinds, types, and characters, including the services of 30 overprinting, and photographic processing incidental to printing, the 31 processing of scrap metal into grades and bales for further processing into 32 steel and other metals, the retreading of tires for automobiles, trucks, and 33 other mobile equipment powered by electrical or internal combustion engines or motors, and the rebuilding or remanufacturing of used parts for automobiles, 34 35 trucks, and other mobile equipment powered by electrical or internal 36 combustion engines or motors if the rebuilt or remanufactured parts are not

sold directly to the consumer but are sold for resale, and the production of protective coatings which increase the quality and durability of a finished product, and the production of ready mixed concrete.
