17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 SECTION 1. (a) All admission tickets to motion picture theaters shall
20 be labeled on the face in a readable and conspicuous form to show the Motion
21 Picture Association of America rating as in effect January 1, 2001 of the
22 motion picture for which the ticket is sold.

23 (b) It is unlawful for any person to sell an admission ticket to, or
24 otherwise admit, any person under eighteen (18) years of age to a motion
25 picture that carries an (R) or (NC-17) rating from the Motion Picture
26 Association of America as in effect January 1, 2001.

27 (c) No motion picture theater owner, manager or employee shall allow
28 any person under eighteen (18) years of age to enter or remain in a place
29 which is presently showing a motion picture that carries an (R) or (NC-17)
30 rating from the Motion Picture Association of America as in effect January 1,
31 2001.

32 (d) Any person who is found to have violated this act shall be guilty of
33 a Class A misdemeanor.
