AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-4-404 TO ALLOW CREDIT FOR JAIL TIME SPENT AWAITING TRANSFER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION OR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY PUNISHMENT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO AMEND ARKANSAS CODE 5-4-404 TO ALLOW CREDIT FOR JAIL TIME SPENT AWAITING TRANSFER TO THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION OR THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY PUNISHMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 5-4-404 is amended to read as follows:

5-4-404. Credit for time spent in custody.

If a defendant is held in custody for conduct that results in a sentence to imprisonment, or confinement as a condition of suspension or probation, the court, the Department of Correction, or the Department of Community Punishment shall credit the time spent in custody, including time spent in a local jail facility awaiting transfer to the Department of Correction or the Department of Community Punishment, against the sentence.
