21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 6-18-207(a), pertaining to the minimum age
24 for enrollment in kindergarten, is amended to read as follows:

25 (a)(1) Except as provided in subdivisions (a)(2) and (a)(3) of this
26 subsection, ~~Students~~ students may enter kindergarten in the public schools of
27 this state if they will attain the age of five (5) years on or before
28 September 15 of the year in which they are seeking initial enrollment.

29 (2) Any student who has been enrolled in a state-accredited or
30 state-approved kindergarten program in another state for at least sixty (60)
31 days, who will become five (5) years old during the year in which he is
32 enrolled in kindergarten, and who meets the basic residency requirement for
33 school attendance may be enrolled in kindergarten upon written request to the
34 school district.

35 (3) Any student born on or after September 15, 1996 and before
36 October 1, 1996, may enter kindergarten in the public schools of this state

1 if they will attain the age of five (5) years on or before October 1 of the
2 year in which they are seeking initial enrollment.
