19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 27-14-601(a)(6)(C) is amended to read as
22 follows:

23 (C) When a dealer's master license plate or extra license plate is
24 attached to any dealer-owned motor vehicle, the motor vehicle may be driven
25 or operated upon the public highways for any purpose ~~consistent with the~~
26 ~~operation of the dealership, by~~ of the licensed dealer or any other person
27 authorized by the licensed dealer.

29 SECTION 2. Arkansas Code 27-14-601(a)(6)(D) is repealed.

30 (D) Any dealer who pleads guilty or nolo contendere to, or who is
31 found guilty of, the misuse of a dealer license plate or of allowing anyone
32 else to misuse a dealer license plate shall be fined not more than two
33 hundred fifty dollars (\$250) for the first offense, not more than five
34 hundred dollars (\$500) for the second offense, and not more than one thousand
35 dollars (\$1000) for the third and subsequent offenses.
