8 AN ACT TO CREATE THE DIVISION OF CAPITOL POLICE
9 WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE POLICE;
10 AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

12 TO CREATE THE DIVISION OF CAPITOL POLICE
13 WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT OF ARKANSAS STATE
14 POLICE.
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18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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20 SECTION 1. (a) Effective July 1, 2002, there is created the Division
21 of Capitol Police within the Department of Arkansas State Police.

22 (b) The Department of Arkansas State Police shall use the salary and
23 grade structure, benefits and retirement systems in effect on July 1, 2001,
24 for the division transferred to the department by this act.

25 (c) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police is
26 authorized to adopt reasonable rules, regulations and procedures, not
27 inconsistent with the law, which he deems desirable for the effective
28 administration of the division created by this act.
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30 SECTION 2. (a) All personnel employed by the department affected by
31 this act shall be deemed to have met all employment standards and
32 qualifications required by the Department of Arkansas State Police and shall
33 be granted employment at their current rank and salary grade upon passage of
34 this act.

35 (b) The Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police shall
36 appoint the head of the division who shall serve at the pleasure of the

1 director. However, nothing in this section shall be so construed as to
2 reduce any right which an employee of the *division* shall have under any civil
3 service or merit system.

4 (c) This division shall be under the direction, control, and
5 supervision of the Director of the Department of Arkansas State Police. The
6 director may delegate his functions, powers, and duties to the *division* of
7 the department as he shall deem desirable and necessary for the effective and
8 efficient operation of the department.

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10 SECTION 3. Effective July 1, 2002, the State Capitol Police is
11 transferred by a Type 2 transfer, as provided in Arkansas Code 5-2-105, to
12 the Department of Arkansas State Police.

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14 SECTION 4. All other statutory authority, powers, duties, functions,
15 records, property and funds administered or provided by other support
16 divisions within the *State Capitol Police* transferred by this act shall be
17 transferred by a Type 2 transfer, as provided in Arkansas Code 25-2-105, to
18 the Department of Arkansas State Police on July 1, 2002.

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20 SECTION 5. The *division* transferred by this act and the Department of
21 Information Systems shall grant access to and provide information as
22 determined by the Department of Arkansas State Police necessary to
23 successfully accomplish its mission.
