14 TO ALLOW COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT
15 SYSTEMS TO COLLECT AN ADDITIONAL FEE FOR
16 THE PICKUP AND DISPOSAL OF LARGE
17 APPLIANCES.
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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code 8-6-212(e), concerning the authority of the
24 county to enact a solid waste management system ordinance, is amended to read
25 as follows:

26 (e)(1) A county shall have the right to issue orders, to establish
27 policies for, and to enact ordinances concerning all phases of the operation
28 of a solid waste management system, including hours of operation, the
29 character and kinds of wastes accepted at the disposal site, the levying of
30 additional service charges for the handling of large appliances or any large
31 waste objects, the separation of wastes according to type by those generating
32 them prior to collection, the type of container for storage of wastes, the
33 prohibition of burning of wastes, the pretreatment of wastes, and such other
34 rules as may be necessary or appropriate, so long as such orders, policies,
35 and ordinances are consistent with, in accordance with, and not more
36 restrictive than, those adopted by, under, or pursuant to this subchapter or

1 any other laws, rules, regulations, or orders adopted by state law or
2 incorporated by reference from federal law, the Arkansas Pollution Control and
3 Ecology Commission, or the regional solid waste management boards or
4 districts, unless there exists a fully implemented comprehensive area-wide
5 zoning plan and corresponding laws or ordinances covering the entire county or
6 unless the county has made a request to the regional solid waste management
7 board or district to adopt a more restrictive rule, regulation, order, or
8 standard and no public hearing has been held within sixty (60) days or the
9 request has not been acted upon within ninety (90) days.

10 (2) For the purposes of this subsection (e), "large waste object"
11 means a single object that will not fit within a receptacle provided by the
12 county for solid waste collection or an object that will not fit into those
13 solid waste receptacles commonly available in department, discount, or
14 hardware stores.

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
