24	<u>(a) A municipa</u>	lity that regulates the placement, s	screening, or height
25	of radio antennas shall reasonably accommodate amateur radio antennas. A		
26	municipality may requ	ire reasonable and customary enginee	ering practices to be
27	followed in the erection of amateur radio antennas. A municipality may impose		
28	only the minimum requirement relating to amateur radio antennas that are		
29	necessary to accompli	sh legitimate purposes intended to b	oe served by the
30	<u>requirements.</u>		
31	<u>(b) A municipa</u>	lity may not restrict the number of	support structures
32	for an amateur radio antenna. Based on the most recent federal decennial		
33	census, a municipal restriction on amateur radio antenna height may not be		
34	lower than:		
35	<u>(1) Two</u>	hundred (200) feet above the ground	level as permitted
36	hy the Federal Commun	ications Commission in an area with	a nonulation density

2	(2) Seventy-five (75) feet above the ground level in an area

6	area with a population density of more than one hundred twenty (120) persons		
7	per square mile on a lot that is one (1) acre or larger.		
8	(c) Subject to subsections (a) and (b) of this section, a municipalit		
9	may, by ordinance, impose requirements to meet clearly defined objectives		
10	relating to screening, placement, aesthetics, and health and safety factors		
11	with respect to the erection, maintenance, and operation of amateur radio		
12	antennas.
